- Bears are attracted to food, when using Ashams beach always keep your campsite/area clean.
- Dispose of your garbage at a bin away from your site before sleeping or when you are done using the campsites and beach area. This will help curb their interest to come around the sites. Its everyone's responsibility to help keep the beach clean so everyone can enjoy it.
- With the coulees and available bush cover. They can be anywhere. Black bears usually active in the evening and into the night. They can be nocturnal as well.
- If you are berry picking or out an about, make noise. Either with a portable speaker or invest in a bear bell.
- Be mindful of your surroundings, your children and small pets.
