

- YOUNG ADULTS AGED 18-26 WHO WERE IN CARE
- YOUTH WHO WERE IN FNCFS CARE & LEFT VOLUNTARILY BEFORE THE AGE OF MAJORITY
- YOUTH WHO WERE IN FNCFS CARE ON THE DAY THEY REACHED THE AGE OF MAJORITY
