This advisory is being issued due to water main breaks and repairs in subdivisions two and three.

We are recommending a Precautionary Boil Water (PBWA) until such time as the leaks are repaired and:

- A free chlorine level of at least 0.2 milligrams/Litre (mg/L).
- One negative bacterial samples.

Pasqua First Nation Precautionary Boil Water Advisory June 3, 2025

This notice is to advise you that due to Water line breaks and repairs, which can cause a loss in pressure.

During the repairs it is necessary to shut off the water, bottled water will be provided by Pasqua First Nation until the water is turned back on at which time:

- We are recommending a, Precautionary Boil Water (PBWA) until:
- 1. A free chlorine level of at least 0.2 milligrams/Litre (mg/L).
- 2. One negative bacterial sample.

You are advised to boil water that is to be used for **drinking**, **cooking or brushing your teeth**, for 3 minutes before it is used.

You will be notified once testing is completed to ensure that the water is safe to drink.
