- Enjoy working with a team?
- Want to learn new things?

What is Search and Rescue?

SAR is an organized, urgent search for and provision of aid to people who are lost, missing, stranded, or in distress, primarily to save lives. Conducted by trained volunteers, who are overseen by RCMP.

How do I get involved or want to know more?

To become a member, you must join your local SAR chapter. FHQTC has an established SAR Chapter under the Search and Rescue Saskatchewan Association of Volunteers (SARSAV). Consisting of members recruited from the surrounding First Nation's. Pasqua has a team that is under the FHQTC chapter, who at this time will be allowed to **bring 4 observers** to the upcoming member meeting.

If you are interested in being an observer, you must be able to meet these criteria:

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Must be able to pass a criminal record and vulnerable sector check.
- Must be a Canadian citizen **(for the purpose of being within the service/activation area with the Pasqua team, must be a carded member of Pasqua First Nation and must reside on the nation).**
- Must have a certain level of physical fitness. Be able to walk extended periods of time and be able to lift and carry 50lbs for an extended period of time.

As an observer, you will be attending the meeting, where you will be able to:

- Learn about the operations and tactics used by SAR.
- Learn about the equipment we use.
- Learn about upcoming training and opportunities within the FHQTC SAR chapter.
- Observe a training exercise conducted by Ground SAR members and Drone SAR operators.

Must pre-register with Nolan Stevenson as there are only 4 spots available at this time.
