



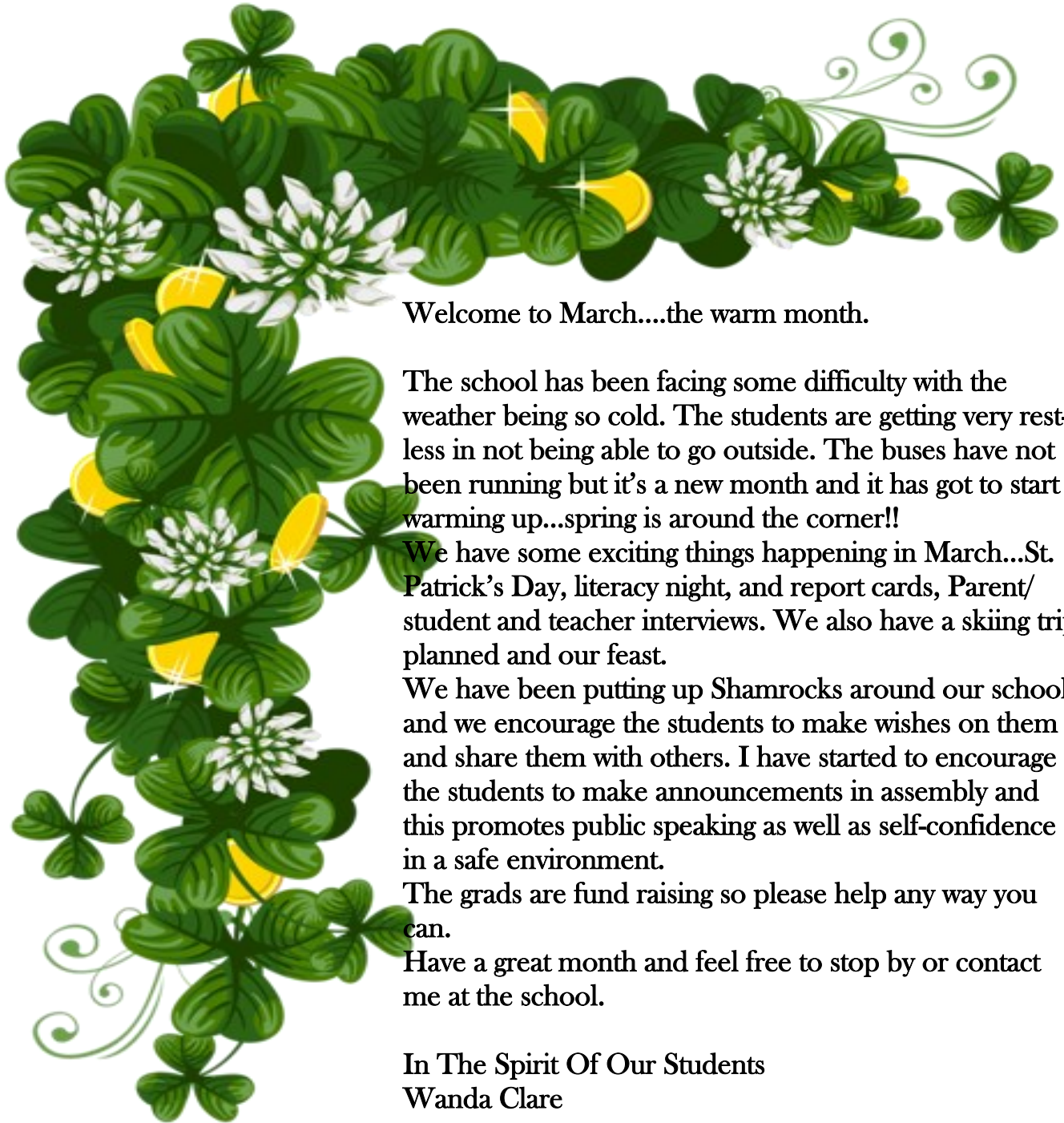

## KINDERGARTEN-MS. SAULTEAUX

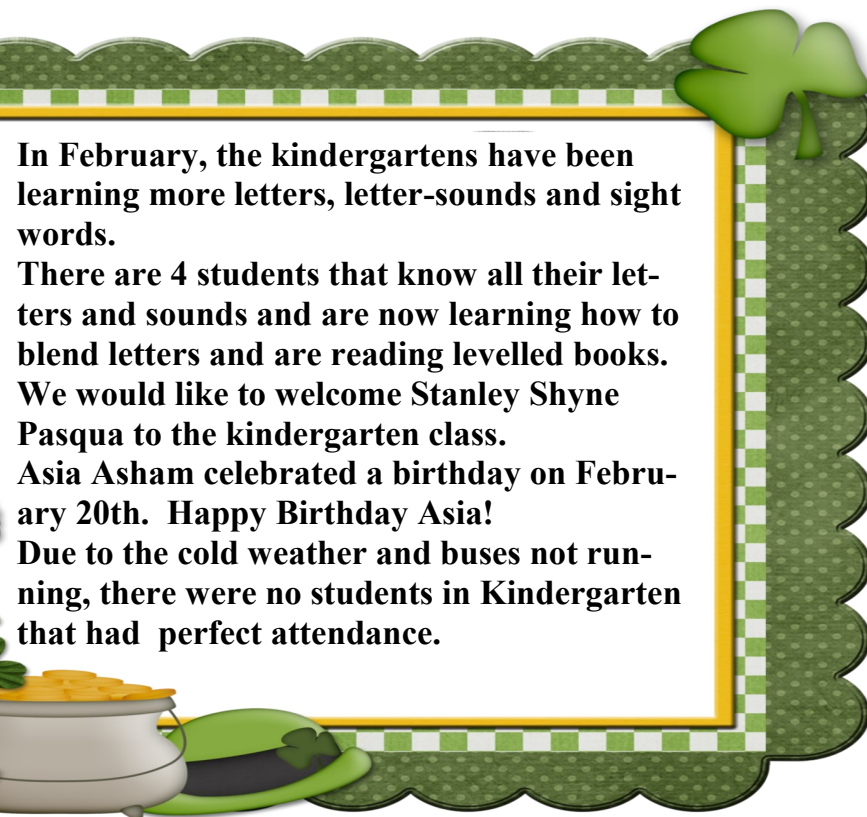
In February, the kindergartens have been learning more letters, letter-sounds and sight words.

There are 4 students that know all their letters and sounds and are now learning how to blend letters and are reading levelled books.

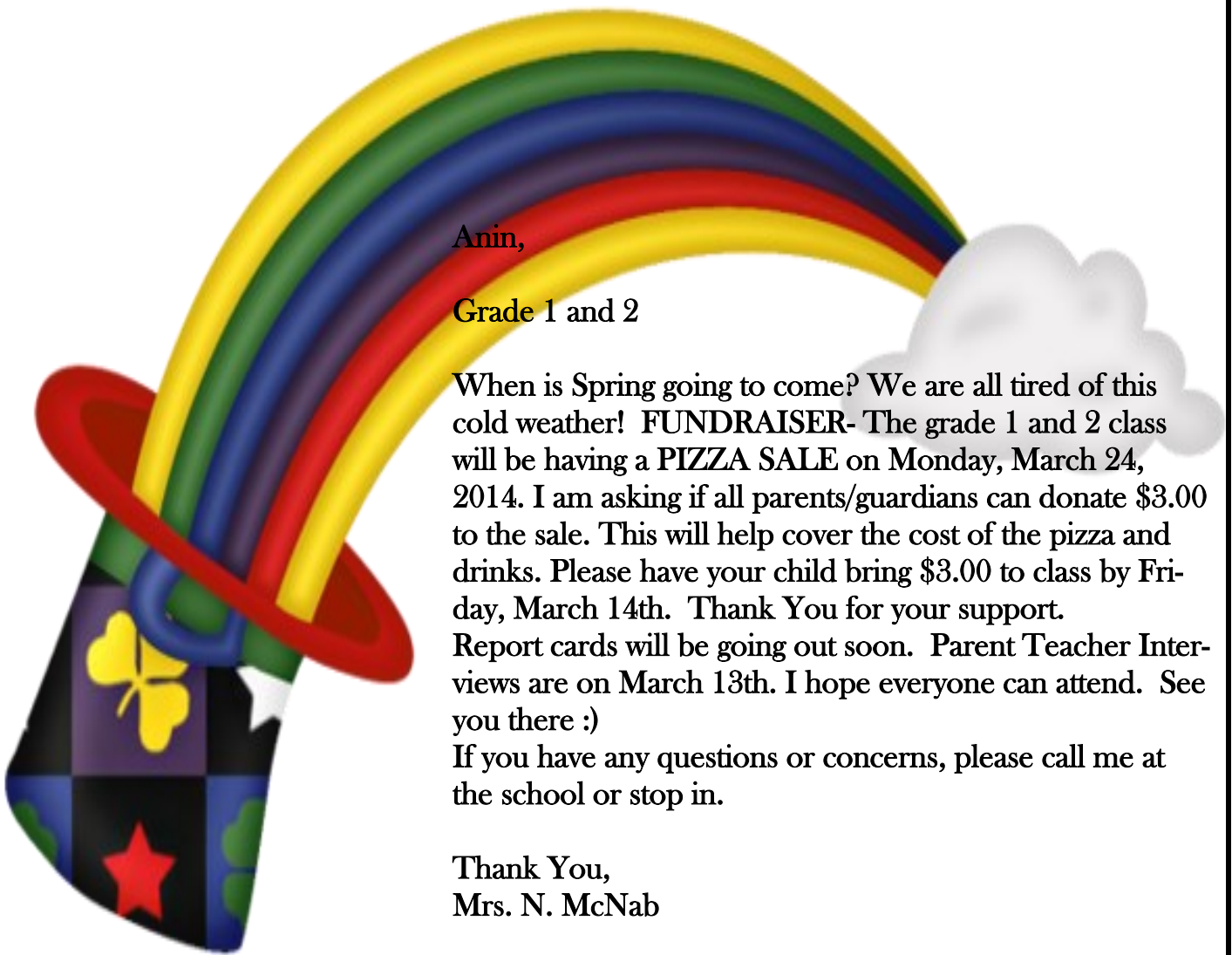
We would like to welcome Stanley Shyne Pasqua to the kindergarten class.
