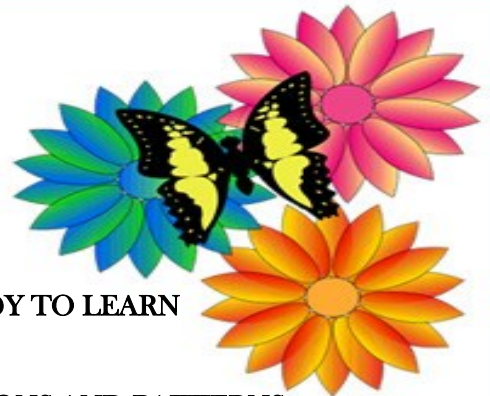

SUPPORT FOR I KNOW THEY WILL ALL SUCCEED.

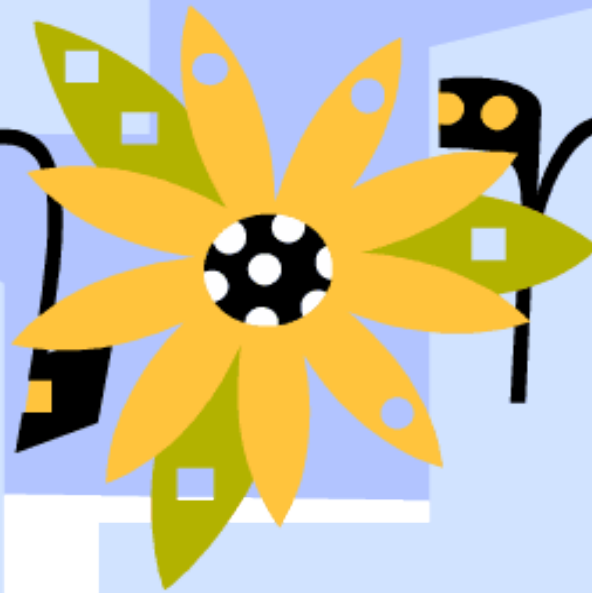
WE HAD A CLASS ELECTION AND SHAWNA DUBOIS WAS VOTED AS CLASS
